INTRODUCTION

There is a group of mothers who have decided to partner with one another in educating their children. Realizing that it would be difficult to do it alone, they decided to share the responsibility. During this process, they also learned to partner with God in this task. They pray for God direction, wisdom and leading each day and He answers!

The ability to reach out in prayer and have our prayers answered in return, this is made possible only through the Lord Jesus Christ.

I am part of this group of mothers. We have learned that everything can be discussed with God in a simple way. We do not need to use big words or elaborate phrases in our conversation with Him. We can talk to Him as we would with a friend or a father. The bible says that God is, in fact, our heavenly father. God desires to hear from us, and as as we ask, he answers and will guide us day by day in raising and teaching our children.

This book was created with the intent of helping parents to build a partnership with Christ and to begin a daily prayer routine. When you build the habit to pray everyday you experience the liberation and freedom of knowing that you do not have to do everything alone and the understanding that you are not alone!

The group of mothers I mentioned is part of a mothers' movement called "WakeUp Deborah". These ladies are committed to pray 15 minutes each day for their children. My prayer is that every time you open this book, you will encounter God in a new way as you pray for your children and will witness the precious fruit of those answered prayers in the lives of your children!







TOOLS TO PRAY

This section provides some groundwork on what prayer is and how to pray. If you are new to prayer, you will find some simple strategies on how to get started.

What is Prayer?

Prayer is a conversation between you and God. It may sound simple but in reality it can be a little overwhelming if you are just starting out, especially if you are trying to pray for 15 minutes and don't know what to say.

Here are some tools that can help you build a strong prayer life:

Prayer Notebook

I have found that it is helpful to have a notebook for each child I am committed to praying for. I recommend that you have one as well. Write down the date and areas you feel your child's life needs to be covered in prayer. If you need some ideas, look at section 04: 40 Reasons To Pray.

Be specific and write detailed prayer requests and how you would like God to bless your child. We have created a template that you can print out and add to your notebook to begin.

HOW TO PRAY

It can sometimes be a struggle to know how to pray, especially if we've allowed our prayer to become routine. Fortunately, the Bible outlines many different types of prayers we can use as a pattern.

The Lord's Prayer is a passage from Jesus' longest, most detailed sermon. Here, Jesus gives us specific direction on how to pray. How amazing is that? This is the exact format of prayer that Jesus tells his disciples to use.

In addition to a formula, Jesus gives further direction in the verses prior to the Lord's Prayer.

Matthew 6: 5-8

"And when you pray, do not be like the hypocrites, for they love to pray standing in the synagogues and on the street corners to be seen by others. Truly I tell you, they have received their reward in full. But when you pray, go into your room, close the door and pray to your Father, who is unseen. Then your Father, who sees what is done in secret, will reward you. And when you pray, do not keep on babbling like pagans, for they think they will be heard because of their many words. Do not be like them, for your Father knows what you need before you ask Him."

Jesus instructs us not to pray for the sake of impressing others but to pray in secret for our own reward.

He also tells us not to be repetitive or to babble on and on as we pray.

Our prayers do not need to be lengthy, extravagant or wordy to be effective.



THE LORD'S PRAYER

Step One: Start With Praise & Worship

"Our Father in heaven, hallowed be your name."

The word "hallowed" here means "honored as holy." The first step to any prayer is to give God glory, honor and praise. This positions our hearts to be aware of God's presence as we pray.

Here, Jesus also directs us to acknowledge God as our Father in heaven. God is the Creator of the universe, the Alpha and Omega, the King of Kings, the Almighty. But, He is also our good, good Father who loves us and wants an intimate relationship with us.

Beginning praying by calling him "Father" and praising His name brings us into His presence the right way; with reverence and awe, but also with intimacy and relationship.

You aren't just praying to a distant, powerful King. You are praying to the loving, tender God of your heart, who knows you fully and loves you deeply. The words we choose have power; don't be hesitant or afraid to call Him your Heavenly Father.

Step Two: Pray God's Will Be Done

"Your kingdom come, your will be done, on earth as it is in heaven."

Jesus tells us to pray God's will over our own because the ultimate goal of prayer is not to convince God of our heart but to align it with His. Praying God's will to be done in our situation puts His agenda before our own. This is the mark of a truly surrendered heart. We can certainly pray specifically for our hearts desires, He knows them anyway. But ultimately our main desire should be for God's will to prevail, even if His will is the opposite of our desire.





THE LORD'S PRAYER

Step Three: Pray For Your Needs

"Give us this day our daily bread,"

Here, Jesus transitions into instructing us to pray for the provision of our needs, no matter how seemingly insignificant or mundane. We need daily bread in the sense that we need God to daily dwell with us and guide us, but also that we need literal daily bread to stay alive. Pray for both His physical and spiritual provision in your life and the lives of those you love. God created us with bodies and souls and each needs daily substance to sustain it. Pray for the things that you need and thank Him for all that He has already blessed you with.

Step Four: Confess Sin & Ask For Forgiveness

"..and forgive us our debts,"

Many times when we pray, we forget these next two steps but they are vitally important to our walk with God. We need to regularly ask God to search our hearts and reveal our sin to us. We need to regularly be confessing those sins to God and asking Him to forgive us.

Prayer is about cultivating a relationship with Jesus and in any relationship, part of intimacy is humility and openness. Humble, open, teachable hearts apologize when they are wrong. Do not leave any sin unconfessed; unrepented sin erodes relationship with God and hinders intimacy with Him. Ask the Lord to search your heart and reveal and any unrepented sin to you.



THE LORD'S PRAYER

Step Five: Ask For Help Forgiving Others

"..as we also have forgiven our debtors."

You may not think that you regularly need to forgive others, but this doesn't just refer to obvious conflicts. This can mean forgiving someone for disappointing you or letting you down as well as forgiving someone who has wronged you. This is not an easy task. Our flesh will fight against this unrelentingly so we need to regularly pray for the strength to forgive others.

Step Six: Pray For Safety, Protection & Deliverance

"And lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil."

Pray for protection and safety, as we have a real enemy who lives to attack God's people.

Pray, as Jesus says, for "deliverance from evil."

PRAYING SCRIPTURES

When you pray, you often talk to God about your own needs and concerns. But did you know that you can also pray scripture back to God? This is a powerful way to connect with God and declare His truth over your life.

Here's how to do it:

CHOOSE SCRIPTURE VERSES that resonates with you. It could be a verse that speaks to your current situation or one that is a personal favorite. Meditate on the verse for a few minutes. What is God saying to you through this verse? How does it apply to your life or your children?

As you reflect on the verse, ask God to help you understand it fully and to apply it to your life in a way that will be pleasing to Him. As you meditate on the scripture and pray it back to God, you will be amazed at how He speaks to you through His Word and how He uses it to transform your life.

READ OR SAY THE VERSES TO GOD. This is a good way to begin your prayer time, especially if you are feeling lost or confused. Tell God about what you are struggling with and ask Him to help you through it. Be open and honest with Him, and let Him know what you need.

As you pray, declare the truth of the scripture over your life and your children. "Remind" God of His promises and thank Him for His faithfulness towards you. When praying scripture back to God, it is important to remember that it's not about "doing it right." Just start praying, and let God work in your life!





PRAYING SCRIPTURES

REPHRASE THE VERSE using your own words. This can be a helpful way to really personalize the scripture and make it your own. For example, here's a verse that I often pray: "Come to me, all you who are weary and burdened, and I will give you rest." (Matthew 11:28)

You might pray this verse by saying something like this: "Lord, I am so tired and overwhelmed. Please come to me and give me rest. Thank you for your promises of peace and restoration." Or, I might change it up a bit depending on my current situation: "Lord, I need Your help right now. Come to me and give me the strength I need to face this challenge. Thank You for Your faithfulness."

TALK TO GOD about what the verse means to you. Share your thoughts and feelings with Him. Thank Him for the truths in the scripture and ask Him to help you apply them to your life.

When you pray scripture back to God, you are opening yourself up to His guidance and wisdom. You are allowing Him to speak directly to your heart and mind, and this is a beautiful way of growing closer to Him. Be open to what He has for you, and let Him show you how powerful His Word can be in your life!



"How great is the love the Father has lavished on us, that we should be called children of God." 1 John 3:1









PRAYER 10: FRIENDSHIP

PRAYER 11: HEALING

PRAYER 12: SELF-ESTEEM

I pray for the healing of traumas of any origin, such as: rejection, inferiority or superiority complex, need due to lack of love, acceptance and any other feeling that can generate rebellion;

PRAYER 13: THE MARGINALIZED

I pray for abandoned children, street children and orphans who live in government institutions. May God, with His immense love, assist them and supply each of their needs;

"Remember those in prison as if you were their fellow prisoners, and those who are mistreated as if you yourselves were suffering" Hebrews 13:3



PRAYER 14: TRUST

I pray that our children will grow stronger in Christ Jesus, showing commitment to God in every action. May they allow, search and feel a burning desire to be molded by Jesus;

"Trust in the LORD with all your heart and lean not on your own understanding; in all your ways submit to Him, and He will make your paths straight." Proverbs 3:5-6

PRAYER 15: SEEK FORGIVENESS

I pray for our children's spiritual growth. Let there be no unconfessed sins, bitter feelings, unforgiveness or discouragement. Let nothing hinder their perfect communion with God;

"If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just and will forgive us our sins and purify us from all unrighteousness" 1 John 1:9

PRAYER 16: INFLUENCE

I pray for the schools and colleges where our children spend most of their day. I pray for every person that has contact with them such as teachers, educational advisors and friends as well as any discipline taught to our children. May the Lord remove any bad company and bad influence trying to penetrate their lives;

"How can a young man keep his way pure? By guarding it according to your word." Psalm 119:9

PRAYER 18: PROVISION

I pray for intellectual capacity and good learning. May our children take pleasure in their studies, at all stages of their lives;

"And my God will supply every need of yours according to His riches in glory in Christ Jesus." Philippians 4:19

PRAYER 17: STABILITY

I pray that God gives our children understanding to reject concepts that are contrary to the word of God - either by teachers or peers;


